Plant materials were ubiquitous in prehistoric material culture and are widely used by indigenous cultures today. Among these, the bark of trees plays a central role because of its flexibility, strength, water repellency and large surface area, which allow it to be used as containers. In this roundtable, six conservators are invited to talk about their experience with the barks of three trees: red cedar, lime and birch. For each type of bark, our guests will explain the structure and degradation pathways, and report on challenge and success in treating, conserving and interpreting the objects.
